

Shavuot Floral Crown/Necklace

There are four sections to the crown:

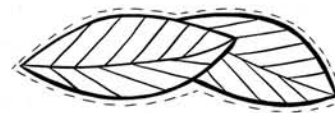
A. The front



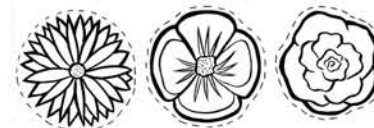
B. The back



C. Side Connector



D. Flowers



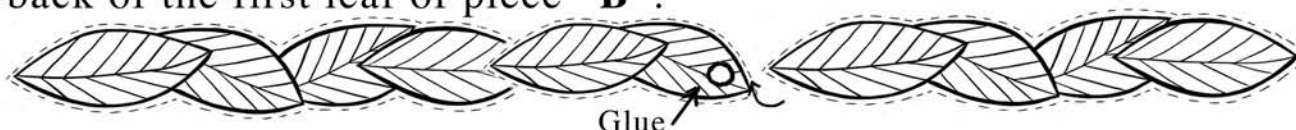
Instructions:

1. Print sheet at full size in landscape, or horizontal format.
2. Color in all sections of the “crown” – flowers and leaves.
3. Cut out each section of the crown (A, B, C and D).
4. Put glue on the end of the last leaf on piece “A” and attach it to the back of the first leaf of the ‘**Side Connector**’.

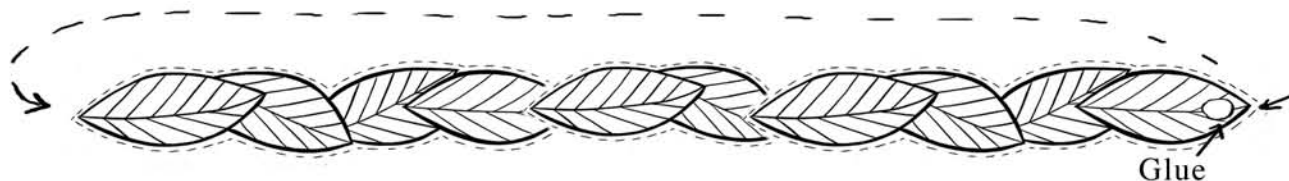
*For smaller heads you may need less of the connector, or no connector at all. (For no connector, tape **Sides A & B** together in the back).



5. Place glue on the tip of the last leaf of the ‘**Side Connector**’. Attach the back of the first leaf tip to the back of the first leaf of piece “B”.



6. Put glue on the end of the leaf tip on piece “B” and attach it to the back of piece “A”, bringing the crown full circle.



Attach end of **Side B** to **back of Section A** as described in steps 5 & 6, creating a full, circular crown.

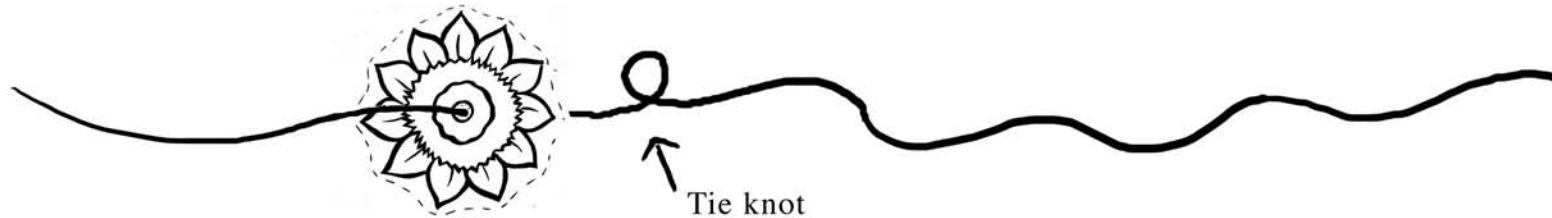
7. Decorate crown with flowers (‘**Section D**’) by gluing as many as you want around the crown.



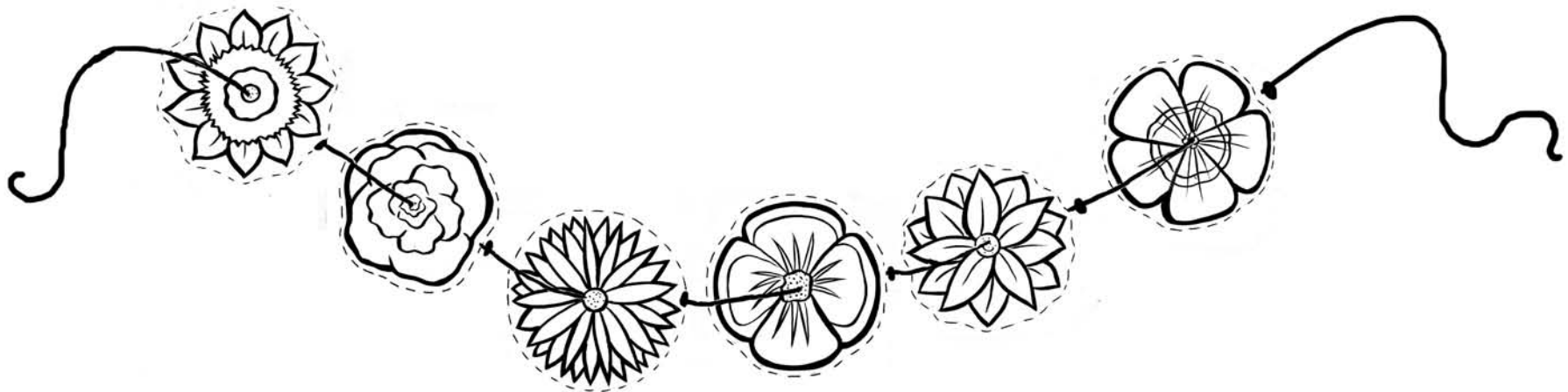

Instructions (Continued)

8. Alternatively, print out extra flowers and create a necklace!
9. Take a piece of string (yarn may be best).
10. Color in all flowers.
11. Poke a hole through the middle of each flower.
12. Pull the string through a flower. Tie a knot below the flower to secure in place.

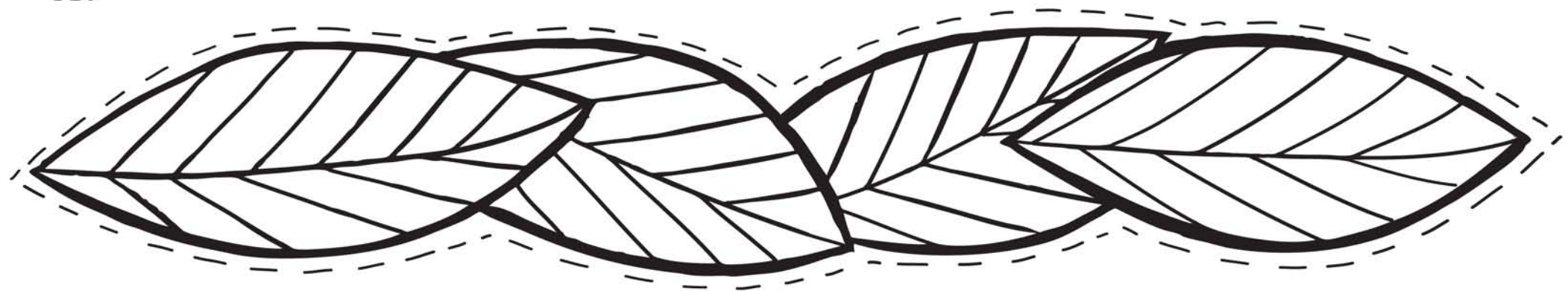


13. Repeat until necklace is full of flowers!
14. Add beads for a variation! When finished decorating necklace, tie a knot.

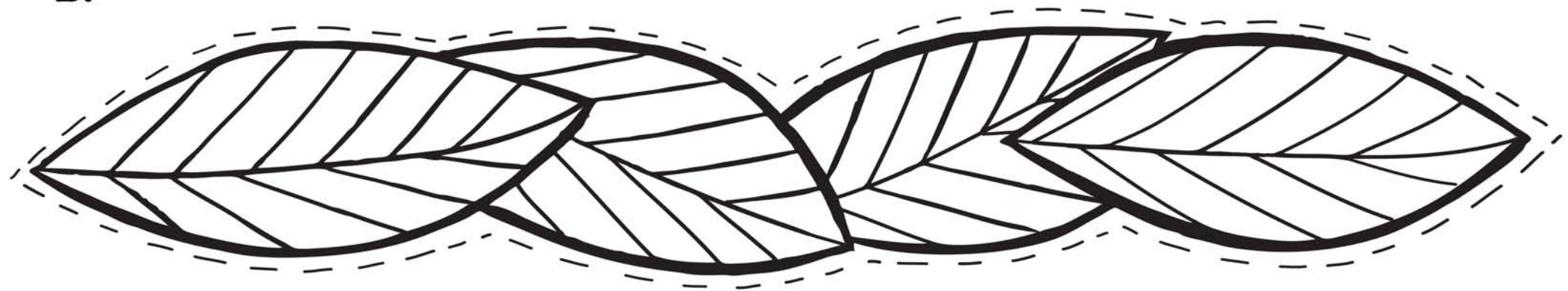


15. Model for the camera – make sure to send us a picture of how royal and festive you look!

16. Wear on Shavuot to decorate yourself, your home and your synagogue with flowers.

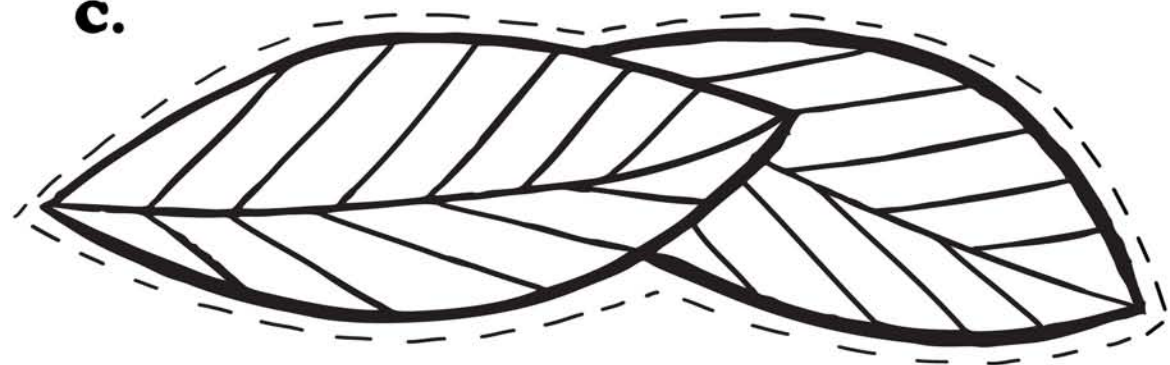
